**Order Postponing Hearing and
Scheduling Prehearing
Conference**

On July 27, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondent has securities registered with the Commission and is delinquent in its periodic filings.

On August 4, 2017, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration reflecting that it served the OIP on Respondent's registered agent by USPS Priority Mail Express, in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(i), (ii) on July 29, 2017. Accordingly, its answer to the OIP is due by August 11, 2017. *See* OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

I ORDER that the hearing currently scheduled for August 21, 2017, is POSTPONED *sine die*, and a telephonic prehearing conference shall be held at 2:00 p.m. Eastern on September 1, 2017, if the proceeding has not been resolved by then.
