**Order Finding Service,  
Postponing Hearing, and  
Scheduling a Prehearing  
Conference**

The Securities and Exchange Commission initiated this matter with an order instituting proceedings (OIP) dated August 2, 2017. On August 15, 2017, the Division of Enforcement submitted a declaration with exhibits concerning service of the OIP on Respondents. Based on this evidence, I find that the OIP was sent by U.S. Postal Service priority mail express to Cortronix Biomedical Advancement Technologies, Inc., HW Holdings, Inc., and Microelectronics Technology Company at the most recent address on each company's most recent filing with the Commission and that these three Respondents were served with the OIP by delivery or attempted delivery by August 8, 2017. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii).

The OIP was also mailed to China Greenstar Corporation at the address in Hong Kong listed on its most recent filing with the Commission. Hong Kong, a special administrative region of China, does not object to service through postal channels under Article 10(a) of the Hague Convention on Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents. *TracFone Wireless, Inc. v. Unlimited PCS Inc.*, 279 F.R.D. 626, 630 (S.D. Fla. 2012). Under these circumstances, the Commission's Rules of Practice permit service by mail to a

person in Hong Kong. 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(iv)(A). China Greenstar was served with the OIP by August 7, 2017.

Respondents' answers are due by August 21, 2017. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b). The hearing currently scheduled for August 22, 2017, is POSTPONED. A telephonic prehearing conference will be held on September 6, 2017, at 3:00 p.m. Eastern time.
