Order to Show Cause

On August 10, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondent under Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

I previously found that Respondent was served with the OIP on August 14, 2017, and its answer was due by August 28, 2017. *E-Waste Sys., Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 4994, 2017 SEC LEXIS 2608 (ALJ Aug. 23, 2017). To date, Respondent has not answered.

I ORDER that by September 8, 2017, Respondent shall SHOW CAUSE why the registration of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failure to file an answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. If Respondent fails to respond to this order, attend the prehearing conference scheduled for September 11, 2017, at 3:00 p.m. EDT, or otherwise defend the proceeding, it will be deemed in default and the registration of its securities will be revoked. OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(1)-(2), .220(f), .221(f).
