**Order Regarding Service on  
Legend International Holdings,  
Inc.**

The Division of Enforcement has submitted the declaration of a professional process server to aid in establishing that the order instituting this proceeding (OIP) has been served on Respondent Legend International Holdings, Inc. The process server states that on August 27, 2017, he left a copy of the OIP and related papers at the office of Corporation Service Company, Legend International's purported registered agent in Delaware.

However, the OIP alleges that Legend International's corporate status in Delaware is void. OIP ¶ 2. If that allegation is true, it has lost all corporate powers and has no registered agent. *See* Del. Code tit. 8, § 510. But if Legend International has no officers, directors, places of business, or other corporate presence in Delaware, service may be made on the Delaware Secretary of State. Del. Code tit. 8, § 321(a)-(b); *see Ross v. Venezuelan-Am. Indep. Oil Producers Ass'n*, 230 F. Supp. 701, 702 (D. Del. 1964) (finding service on a dissolved corporation through the Delaware Secretary of State to be valid).

I therefore ORDER the Division to file a supplemental declaration on the status of service on Legend International by September 8, 2017.
