Sealing Order

At my direction, the parties have submitted declarations regarding personally identifiable information in their hearing exhibits. *See Saving2Retire*, *LLC*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5017, 2017 SEC LEXIS 2715 (ALJ Sept. 5, 2017). The Division of Enforcement proposes redactions to thirty-eight of its exhibits to prevent the disclosure of individuals' social security numbers, addresses, e-mail addresses, account numbers, and similar information. Respondents represent that none of their exhibits contain personally identifiable information.

I find that the harm resulting from the disclosure of the personally identifiable information identified by the Division outweighs the benefits. *See id.* at *1; 17 C.F.R. § 201.322(b). I therefore ORDER that:

- (1) Division Exhibits 2, 4, 7–9, 11–14, 16–18, and 20–45 shall be SEALED.
- (2) Division Exhibits 2R, 4R, 7R–9R, 11R–14R, 16R–18R, and 20R–45R—which the Division redacted and submitted with its September 13, 2017, declaration—shall be ADMITTED in addition to the previously admitted, unredacted exhibits.

The Office of the Secretary shall make corrections and issue a revised record index to reflect the foregoing rulings. See 17 C.F.R. § 201.351(b).
