**Order Extending Deadline for
Depositions**

The Division and Respondent have each submitted a request for a deposition subpoena or subpoenas. I will sign and return the subpoenas to the parties. The Division's and Respondent's cover letters each noted that a deposition is scheduled after the deposition deadline of October 27, 2017, that was proposed by the parties and adopted by my scheduling order. The parties have agreed to extend the schedule. I construe the parties' letters as a motion for an extension of time under 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, and I GRANT the motion. The deadline for depositions is extended to November 2, 2017.

If any further modifications of the schedule are necessary, the parties should submit the request in the form of a motion rather than a letter. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.154.
