Order Postponing Hearing and Scheduling Prehearing Conference

On September 19, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondents under Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The hearing is scheduled to commence on October 24, 2017.

On September 29, 2017, the Division of Enforcement submitted a declaration of service, establishing that it served Respondents with the OIP by September 25, 2017, by mailing the OIP by priority mail express to each Respondent's most recent address shown on its most recent filing with the Commission in accordance with Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), (iv). 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), (iv). As such, Respondents' answers are due by October 10, 2017. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(a)-(b), .220(b).

Ivanhoe Energy, Inc., is located in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada. Canada is a signatory to the Hague Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents in Civil or Commercial Matters, *done* Nov. 15, 1965, 20 U.S.T. 361, 658 U.N.T.S. 163, and does not object under Article 10(a) to service of judicial documents through postal channels. *See Water Splash, Inc. v. Menon*, 137 S. Ct. 1504, 1512 n.7 (2017).
