Order Finding Service and Postponing Hearing

Accordingly, Respondents' answers to the OIP are due by October 10, 2017. See OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160, .220(b).

I ORDER that the hearing currently scheduled for October 25, 2017, is POSTPONED. I will schedule a prehearing conference once Respondents have had an opportunity to file their answers.
