Order Postponing Hearing

On September 26, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondents under Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The hearing is scheduled to commence on October 30, 2017.

On October 5, 2017, the Division of Enforcement submitted a declaration of service, establishing that it served Next Galaxy Corp., Occidental Development Group, Inc., and Sable Natural Resources Corporation with the OIP by September 28, 2017, by mailing the OIP by priority mail express to each Respondent's most recent address shown on its most recent filing with the Commission in accordance with Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii), 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). As such, their answers are due by October 11, 2017. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b).

The declaration also states that the OIP was mailed to Novamex Energy, Inc., at 1610 Woodstead Court, Suite 310, The Woodlands, TX 77380. But the company's most recent filing with the Commission on September 22, 2015, states that the company's offices are located in Suite 330. *See* Novamex Energy, Inc., Current Report (Form 8-K) (Sept. 22, 2015), https://www.sec.gov/Archives/edgar/data/1365748/000072174815000726/ ngle8k092215.htm. Novamex has not yet been served. I ORDER that the hearing is POSTPONED. I will schedule a telephonic prehearing conference once the Division establishes service on Novamex. The Division should file a supplemental declaration by October 20, 2017.
