I POSTPONE the hearing currently scheduled for October 26, 2017. I ORDER a telephonic prehearing conference for October 16, 2017, at 11:00 a.m. Eastern. Respondents are on notice that if they do not answer the OIP, appear at the prehearing conference, or otherwise defend the proceeding, I will deem them in default, determine the proceeding against them, and revoke the registrations of their securities.
