**Order Following
Prehearing Conference**

Yesterday, I held a telephonic prehearing conference at which counsel for the Division of Enforcement and for Respondent David Pruitt, CPA, appeared, as did counsel for non-party L-3 Technologies, Inc.

For the reasons stated on the record, I have reconsidered my order denying in part Respondent's motion for a protective order covering third-party productions. *See David Pruitt, CPA*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5070, 2017 SEC LEXIS 2923 (ALJ Sept. 20, 2017). On reconsideration, Respondent's motion is GRANTED, and I will issue the protective order in a following order.

In addition, Respondent informed me that Timothy Keenan, who is subject to an order to show cause for failure to respond to a subpoena for documents, *David Pruitt, CPA*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5139, 2017 SEC LEXIS 3187 (ALJ Oct. 5, 2017), has now contacted Respondent's counsel. Keenan also submitted a letter to my office in response to my order. Respondent's counsel stated that he considers Keenan's response to be sufficient to satisfy the subpoena at this time. Therefore, the order for Keenan to show cause is DISCHARGED.
