Order Postponing Hearing

On September 18, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondent pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondent has securities registered with the Commission and is delinquent in its periodic filings. A hearing is scheduled for October 23, 2017.

On October 12, 2017, the Division of Enforcement submitted a declaration stating that Respondent is a Cayman Islands corporation located in China, and that it was unsuccessful in serving Respondent's registered agent in the Cayman Islands with the OIP. The Division represents that it will pursue service under the Hague Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents in Civil or Commercial Matters, *done* Nov. 15, 1965, 20 U.S.T. 361, 658 U.N.T.S. 163, by sending the OIP to Respondent in China via the Chinese Central Authority—a process that "has been known to take over a year to perfect." Decl. at 1.

I ORDER that the hearing scheduled for October 23, 2017, is POSTPONED. Given the expected delays in perfecting service, the Division shall file a status report by April 16, 2018. A telephonic prehearing conference shall be scheduled at a later date.
