**Order Finding Service,
Postponing Hearing, and
Directing Respondents to Show
Cause**

On September 26, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondents have securities registered with the Commission and are delinquent in their periodic filings.

On October 11, 2017, the Division of Enforcement submitted a declaration establishing that Respondents were served with the OIP by September 29, 2017, by U.S. Postal Service priority mail express at the address listed on each company's most recent filing with the Commission in accordance with 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). Accordingly, Respondents' answers to the OIP were due by October 12, 2017. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b). To date, no Respondent has filed an answer.

I ORDER that the hearing currently scheduled for October 30, 2017, is POSTPONED. I further ORDER that each Respondent SHOW CAUSE by October 30, 2017, why the registration of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failure to file an answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. If a Respondent fails to respond to this order, it shall be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
