Order to Show Cause

On September 26, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondents under Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

I previously found that three Respondents were served with the OIP by September 28, 2017, with answers due by October 11, 2017, and that Respondent Novamex Energy, Inc., was served on October 7, 2017, with its answer due by October 20, 2017. *Next Galaxy Corp.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release Nos. 5170, 2017 SEC LEXIS 3292, at *1 (ALJ Oct. 13, 2017); 5145, 2017 SEC LEXIS 3213, at *1 (ALJ Oct. 6, 2017). To date, no Respondent has answered.

I ORDER that by November 14, 2017, Respondents shall SHOW CAUSE why the registration of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failure to file answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. If Respondents fail to respond to this order, attend the prehearing conference scheduled for November 14, 2017, at 11:00 a.m. EST, or otherwise defend the

proceeding, they will be deemed in default and the registrations of their securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(1)–(2), .220(f), .221(f).
