**Order Regarding Service
and Postponing Hearing**

On October 24, 2017, the Division of Enforcement submitted an update regarding service of the order instituting proceedings (OIP) on Respondents in this consolidated proceeding. The Division stated that it has still been unable to serve Daryl G. Bank because he is being transported by the U.S. Marshals Service to Virginia in connection with a criminal matter, and service cannot be completed while Bank is in transit. Status Rpt. at 1-2.

The Division also represents that Bobby D. Jones was served on October 4, 2017. *Id.* at 2. In an earlier filing, however, the Division represented that Jones acknowledged service on October 10, 2017. Request for Consolidation of Proceedings at 1. In neither filing did the Division provide proof of such service or explain by what method it was accomplished.

Accordingly, I ORDER the Division to file a supplemental declaration regarding service of the OIP on both Respondents by November 15, 2017. A prehearing conference will be scheduled once service has been established.

I FURTHER ORDER that the hearing scheduled for November 6, 2017, in the Jones matter be POSTPONED.
