I held a telephonic conference with the parties yesterday, December 13, 2017, to address certain issues arising under the Securities and Exchange Commission's order issued November 30, 2017. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10440, 2017 SEC LEXIS 3724, https://www.sec.gov/litigation/opinions/2017/33-10440.pdf. For good cause shown, I find that the deadlines in that order should be modified.

Accordingly, Respondent<sup>1</sup> may submit, by January 26, 2018, any new evidence she deems relevant to reexamination of the record. Respondent may also submit a brief of no more than 3,000 words explaining the relevance of the new evidence and identifying any challenged rulings, findings, or conclusions. The Division of Enforcement will have until February 16, 2018, to file a responsive brief of no more than 3,000 words. By March 9, 2018, I will issue an order upon reconsideration setting forth whether all prior actions taken by me are ratified or revised in any respect.
