Consistent with the Commission's November 30, 2017, order, the parties were given the opportunity to submit new evidence by January 5, 2018, that they deemed relevant to my reexamination of the record. *See Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10440, 2017 SEC LEXIS 3724 (Nov. 30, 2017); *Hui Feng*, Admin Proc. Rulings Release No. 5315, 2017 SEC LEXIS 3926 (ALJ Dec. 7, 2017). No submissions have been received.

Upon reconsideration of the record, I find nothing that requires revision. Therefore, I RATIFY all prior actions taken by an administrative law judge in this proceeding.<sup>1</sup> The process contemplated by the Commission's November 30 order is complete.

Respondents have not shown cause by January 5, 2018, for their failures to participate in this proceeding. I remind the Division of Enforcement that it should file a motion for default and sanctions against Respondents by January 16, 2018.
