The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, on December 28, 2017. The OIP alleges that each Respondent is a corporation with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act and has repeatedly failed to file required periodic reports. The Division of Enforcement is seeking to revoke the registration of Respondents' securities. Only CN Dragon Corp. remains in the proceeding. *See Abakan, Inc.*, Initial Decision Release No. 1232, 2018 SEC LEXIS 346 (A.L.J. Feb. 2, 2018) (revoking the registrations of the registered securities of Abakan, Inc., Car Monkeys Group, and Western Graphite, Inc.).

The OIP provides that each Respondent's Answer is due within ten days of service of the OIP on it. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b). CN Dragon Corp., a defaulted Nevada corporation located in Kowloon, Hong Kong, was served with the OIP on January 8, 2018, by U.S. Postal Service Express Mail attempted delivery at "the most recent address shown on [its] most recent filing with the Commission." 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), (iv). To date, CN Dragon Corp. has failed to file an Answer.

Accordingly, CN Dragon Corp. is ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE, by February 23, 2018, why it should not be deemed to be in default and the registration of its securities revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
