Order Ratifying Prior Actions as to Terrence A. Ballard

On November 30, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order ratifying my appointment as an administrative law judge and requiring me to reconsider all procedural and substantive actions I took in this proceeding. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10440, 2017 SEC LEXIS 3724, at \*1-2. Because this proceeding is stayed as to Robert L. Baker, Jacob B. Herrera, and Michael D. Bowen, I gave Terrence A. Ballard and the Division of Enforcement the opportunity to submit new evidence that they deemed relevant to my reexamination of the record. *Robert L. Baker*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5277, 2017 SEC LEXIS 3880 (ALJ Dec. 6, 2017). The Division of Enforcement submitted a motion requesting that I ratify my prior actions. No other submissions have been received.

Upon reconsideration of the record, I find nothing that requires revision as to Ballard. I therefore RATIFY all my prior actions as to him, including my finding that he is in default for failure to participate in the proceeding.<sup>1</sup>
