Order to Show Cause

On March 16, 2018, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondent pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, alleging that Respondent has securities registered with the Commission and is delinquent in its periodic filings.

On April 2, 2018, the Division of Enforcement submitted a notice of service establishing that Respondent was served with the OIP on March 20, 2018. The due date for Respondent's answer was therefore April 2, 2018. OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b). The Division stated in its submission that counsel for Respondent contacted the Division and requested an extension of time for filing an answer. The Division does not object to such an extension. Respondent, however, has not filed an answer or a motion for an extension.

I ORDER Respondent to SHOW CAUSE by April 13, 2018, why the registration of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failure to file an answer. OIP at 2, 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f).
