On April 30, 2018, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondent. A hearing is currently scheduled for June 4, 2018.

I ORDER that the hearing is POSTPONED.

I FURTHER ORDER the Division of Enforcement to file, by May 22, 2018, a declaration regarding the status of service of the OIP on Respondent.

Once the Division establishes service or Respondent appears in this proceeding, I DIRECT the parties to confer and notify this office of a suggested date and time for a telephonic prehearing conference to occur within two weeks of service.

Finally, I remind the parties that they should refrain from attempting to directly contact me. *Cf.* 17 C.F.R. §§ 200.111(d)(1), 201.120(b) (limiting *ex parte* communication). Communications should generally be filed and served in accordance with the Rules of Practice. *See* 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.150-.153.
