**Order Postponing Hearing and  
Prehearing Conference**

On June 5, 2018, the Division of Enforcement submitted a letter motion in response to my order requesting a status update due to recent developments. *See Black Diamond Asset Mgmt. LLC*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5769, 2018 SEC LEXIS 1303, at \*1 (ALJ June 4, 2018). Because a personal emergency may prevent Respondent Robert Wilson from attending the hearing next week, the parties have agreed to postpone the hearing until sometime between July 30 and August 31, 2018. The Division is currently confirming the availability of witnesses.

I agree with the parties that there is good cause to postpone the hearing. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(a). I therefore GRANT the Division's motion and POSTPONE the hearing scheduled for June 11, 2018, in Brooklyn, New York. I ORDER the parties to file, by June 15, 2018, a joint status report proposing hearing dates based on the availability of the parties and their witnesses. The report should also address the issue raised in the Division's motion regarding potential confusion regarding the location of the rescheduled hearing. In addition, I POSTPONE the prehearing conference scheduled for tomorrow, June 7, 2018; I will reschedule it for a date closer to the new hearing date.
