The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings on May 15, 2018, pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933, Sections 15(b) and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Section 9(b) of the Investment Company Act of 1940. *Timothy C. Scarpino*, Securities Act Release No. 10496, 2018 SEC LEXIS 1130 (OIP). The OIP, pursuant to Respondent's offer of settlement, made various findings of fact and conclusions of law, imposed various sanctions, and ordered additional proceedings to determine what, if any, civil penalties against him are in the public interest. The OIP ordered the hearing on this issue to be convened "following the entry of a final judgment against the last remaining defendant(s) in any action(s) arising out of or related to the facts in this [OIP] ("Related Actions")." *Id.* at *23. The OIP does not otherwise identify any Related Actions. It is assumed that such final judgment has not yet been entered.

On June 21, 2018, "[i]n light of the Supreme Court's decision in *Lucia v. SEC*," No. 17-130 (U.S. June 21, 2018), the Commission issued an order staying all pending administrative proceedings "effective immediately;" the stay is to "remain operative for 30 days or further order of the Commission." *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act Release No. 10510, 2018 SEC LEXIS 1490.

In light of this development, any scheduled dates in this proceeding are postponed *sine die*, and no procedural dates will be scheduled while the stay is operative.
