Order Regarding Three Proceedings Post *Lucia v. SEC*, 138 S. Ct. 2044 (2018)

The parties in these three, unconsolidated administrative proceedings have not agreed to alternative procedures by the September 7, 2018, deadline set by the Commission's order of August 22, 2018. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10536, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2058; *see also Pending Admin. Proc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5955, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2264 (A.L.J. Sept. 12, 2018). Citing settlement discussions, the parties in A.P. File No. 3-15974 requested a two-week extension of the deadline, and the parties in A.P. File Nos. 3-16349 and 3-17550 requested an indefinite abeyance.

The Commission's rules do not allow for indefinite postponements. See 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.161, .360(a)(2). Accordingly, by September 28, 2018, I will assign each proceeding to a judge who has not previously participated in the proceeding if the parties in each proceeding do not file a joint motion for a stay pursuant to 17 C.F.R § 201.161(c)(2) or an agreement waiving their right to a new hearing before an administrative law judge who has not previously participated in the proceeding.
