Order Following Reassignment

This proceeding was assigned to me following the Securities and Exchange Commission's order dated August 22, 2018. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10536, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2058; *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5955 (ALJ Sept. 12, 2018).

I have not reviewed the previous record except as it pertains to service of the order instituting proceedings on Respondent Yanglin Soybean.¹ It appears that service has not yet been established. I direct the Division of Enforcement to file a report on the status of service by October 9, 2018.

If Respondent fails to participate by not submitting a proposal, and I find that it has been served with the OIP but never filed an answer, I may enter
