Order Following Reassignment

This proceeding was assigned to me following the Securities and Exchange Commission's order dated August 22, 2018. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10536, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2058, at *2–3; *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5955, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2264 (ALJ Sept. 12, 2018).¹ I direct the parties to submit proposals for the conduct of further proceedings by October 9, 2018. If possible, the parties should confer and submit a joint proposal that reflects any agreement regarding service of the order instituting proceedings (OIP) and addresses the numbered items in 17 C.F.R. § 201.221(c). If the Division of Enforcement is unable to contact Respondents, it should submit a notice to that effect by October 9, 2018.

The previously assigned administrative law judge revoked the registration of Respondents' securities by default. If Respondents again fail to participate by not submitting a proposal, and I find that they have been served with the OIP but never filed an answer, I may enter an initial decision
