Order Following Reassignment

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 on May 15, 2018. The order instituting proceedings alleges that on May 1, 2018, Angela Rubbo Beckcom Monaco pleaded guilty to one count of conspiracy to commit mail and wire fraud in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1349, and one count of engaging in a monetary transaction in property derived from a specific unlawful activity in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1957, in *United States v. Monaco*, 17-cr-417 (D. Colo.).

The proceeding was assigned to me following the Commission's August 22, 2018, order, *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10536, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2058, which vacated any prior opinions and allowed an opportunity for a hearing before an administrative law judge who had not previously participated in the proceeding unless the parties agreed to alternative procedures. *See Pending Admin. Proc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5955, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2264 (ALJ Sept. 12, 2018).

I direct the parties to submit proposals for the conduct of further proceedings by October 15, 2018, and to consider items referenced in 17 C.F.R. § 201.221(c).
