ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 on May 31, 2017. Each Respondent's Answer was due within ten days of service of the OIP on it. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b). Cardinal Resources, Inc., settled,¹ and on July 5, 2017, an Initial Decision of Default revoked the registration of StationDigital Corp.'s registered securities. *Cardinal Res., Inc.*, Initial Decision No. 1151, 2017 SEC LEXIS 2017 (A.L.J.), *finality order*, Exchange Act Release No. 81834, 2017 SEC LEXIS 3200 (Oct. 5, 2017). StationDigital Corp. had been served with the OIP on June 3, 2017, by USPS Express Mail attempted delivery at "the most recent address shown on [its] most recent filing with the Commission," pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), and failed to file an Answer.

On August 22, 2018, in light of *Lucia v. SEC*, 138 S. Ct. 2044 (2018), the Commission ordered a new hearing in each pending proceeding, including this one, before an administrative law judge who had not previously participated in the proceeding, unless the parties expressly agreed to alternative procedures, including agreeing that the proceeding remain with the previous presiding administrative law judge. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10536, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2058, at *2-3. Accordingly, the proceeding was reassigned to the undersigned. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5955, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2264 (C.A.L.J. Sept. 12, 2018).

In view of the reassignment of the proceeding, StationDigital Corp. was afforded a new opportunity to file an Answer, which was due by October 5, 2018. *Cardinal Res., Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 6076, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2583 (Sept. 25, 2018). To date, it has failed to file an Answer. Accordingly, StationDigital Corp. IS ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE, by October 17, 2018, why it should not be deemed to be in default and the registration of its securities revoked. *See* OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f).
