Order to Show Cause

This proceeding began with an order instituting proceedings (OIP) on August 22, 2017. Respondent accepted service of the OIP on October 13, 2017. 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(4). Respondent participated in parts of the proceeding. An initial decision granted the Division of Enforcement's motion for summary disposition; this decision was vacated by the Securities and Exchange Commission and the matter was remanded and reassigned to me.

I directed the parties to submit proposals for the conduct of further proceedings by October 12, 2018. The Division submitted a proposal and stated it was unable to contact Respondent. Respondent did not submit a proposal.

Therefore, I ORDER Respondent to SHOW CAUSE by October 25, 2018, why the proceeding should not be determined on default due to his failure to submit a proposal or participate in this proceeding after remand. 17 C.F.R. § 201.155(a); *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10536, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2058, at *4 (Aug. 22, 2018).
