Order Regarding Service

On September 18, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondent under Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Respondent is a Korean corporation located in Korea, and has not yet been served with the OIP. The Division of Enforcement's last report indicated that Korea had refused to serve the OIP under the Hague Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents in Civil or Commercial Matters,¹ and that the Division was pursuing alternate means of service and intended to file a motion.

I ORDER the Division to file an update or motion regarding the status of service by November 2, 2018.
