**Order Canceling
Prehearing Conference and
Directing Parties to File a
Supplemental Joint Report**

The prehearing conference scheduled for today, October 18, 2018, is CANCELED.

I ORDER the parties to file a supplemental joint report by November 1, 2018, addressing the following issues:

1. What is the factual basis for the parties' conclusion that *United States v. OZ Africa Management GP*, No. 16-cr-515 (E.D.N.Y.), and *United States v. Cohen*, No. 17-cr-544 (E.D.N.Y.), are "actions related to the conduct described" in the order instituting proceedings (OIP)?
2. What is the basis for the parties' contention that the language in the OIP directing that a hearing be convened "following the entry of a final judgment against the last remaining defendant(s) in ... *all* actions related to the conduct described" in the OIP applies only to civil actions involving the SEC and not the two criminal actions previously identified? OIP at 45 (emphasis added).

If required, the parties may seek a protective order to file the supplemental joint report under seal. 17 C.F.R. § 201.322.
