**Scheduling Order**

Based on the parties' separate proposed prehearing schedules, I ORDER the following schedule:

- November 30, 2018: Respondent files new answer to order instituting proceedings or states intention to rely on previously filed answer.
- December 7, 2018: Exchange preliminary fact witness lists.
- January 4, 2019: Disclose expert witnesses.
- January 28, 2019: Exchange and file expert reports, if any.
- February 22, 2019: Deadline for requests under Rule of Practice 232 for deposition subpoenas and for subpoenas to produce documents.
- March 1, 2019: Deadline for fact depositions.  
Exchange rebuttal expert reports.
- March 8, 2019: Produce any previously undisclosed materials in the investigatory file under Rule of Practice 230.
- March 15, 2019: Deadline for expert depositions.
- March 29, 2019: File Rule 250 motions, which must be accompanied by a motion for leave to file the motion for summary disposition.
- April 19, 2019: File oppositions to Rule 250 motions.

- April 26, 2019: File replies to Rule 250 motions.
- April 29, 2019: Exchange and file witness and exhibit lists.
- May 10, 2019: File motions in limine, including objections to witness and exhibit lists.
- File stipulations, admissions of fact, and requests for official notice.
- Deadline for requests under Rule 232 for subpoenas requiring the attendance and testimony of a witness at the hearing.
- May 17, 2019: File oppositions to motions in limine.
- May 21, 2019: File prehearing briefs.
- May 22, 2019: File replies to motions in limine.
- May 24, 2019: Exchange premarked exhibits and final witness lists.
- Deadline to amend witness lists.
- May 29, 2019: Final telephonic prehearing conference at 11:00 a.m. EDT.
- June 3, 2019: The hearing will begin at 9:30 a.m. at a location to be determined in New York.

The hearing guidelines described in the May 26, 2017, order remain in effect.
