ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding with an Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP), pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 on May 16, 2018. The OIP alleges that each Respondent is a corporation with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act and has repeatedly failed to file required periodic reports. The Division of Enforcement is seeking to revoke the registration of Respondents' securities.

On August 22, 2018, in light of *Lucia v. SEC*, 138 S. Ct. 2044 (2018), the Commission ordered a new hearing in each pending proceeding, including this one, before an administrative law judge who had not previously participated in the proceeding, unless the parties expressly agreed to alternative procedures, including agreeing that the proceeding remain with the previous presiding administrative law judge. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10536, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2058, at *2-3. Accordingly, the proceeding was reassigned to the undersigned. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5955, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2264 (C.A.L.J. Sept. 12, 2018).

Each Respondent was served with the OIP on May 18, 2018, by U.S. Postal Service Express Mail attempted delivery at "the most recent address shown on [its] most recent filing with the Commission." 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii). Ultimate Rack Inc. filed an Answer on June 19, 2018. In view of the reassignment of the proceeding, Solaris Power Cells, Inc., and Stragenics, Inc., which had not filed Answers, were afforded a new opportunity to file Answers, which were due by October 12, 2018. Solaris Power Cells, Inc., Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 6095, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2611 (Sept. 26, 2018). To date, neither has filed an Answer. Accordingly, Solaris Power Cells, Inc., and Stragenics, Inc., are each ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE, by November 5, 2018, why it should not be deemed to be in default and the registration of its securities revoked. See OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), .220(f).
