Order Finding Service and Scheduling Prehearing Conference

On June 20, 2018, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondents under Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proceeding was reassigned to me on September 12, 2018. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5955, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2264, at *2–3 (ALJ). The parties were provided the opportunity to propose how further proceedings should be conducted. *FuelNation, Inc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 6011, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2391 (ALJ Sept. 18, 2018). Neither of the Respondents filed a proposal, and the Division of Enforcement represents that it was unable to contact either Respondent.

On June 26, 2018, the Division submitted a declaration of service that demonstrating that it served Respondents with the OIP by June 23, 2018, by mailing the OIP by U.S. Postal Service Priority Mail Express to each Respondent's most recent address shown on its most recent filing with the Commission. The Division's submission establishes that Respondents were served in accordance with Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(ii). See 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii).

The Commission stayed this proceeding in June 2018. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10510, 2018 SEC LEXIS 1490 (June 21, 2018). In a later order, the Commission allowed the stay to expire and provided that "[a]ny pending deadlines"—which would include the deadline for Respondents' answers—"are hereby vacated." *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act Release No. 10536, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2058, at *3 (Aug. 22, 2018). In light of the Commission's order, Respondents are given until

November 5, 2018, to file an answer to the OIP. See OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. $\S\S~201.161(a), .220(b).$

I FURTHER ORDER that a telephonic prehearing conference will be held on November 15, 2018, at 11:00 a.m. EST.
