Order Regarding Service

On August 8, 2017, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an order instituting proceedings (OIP) against Respondent under Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. On August 28, 2017, the Division of Enforcement filed a declaration regarding service of the OIP. Exhibit 2 to the Division's declaration is a print-out of U.S. Postal Service tracking results page. This print-out (Tracking Number EI283507266US) shows that the OIP was delivered and signed for in Silver Springs, Nevada, on August 18, 2017. Paragraph 2 of the declaration states, however, that the Office of the Secretary mailed the OIP to Respondent's registered agent in Silver Springs, Nevada, with a different tracking number: EF177630575US. The U.S. Postal Service's online tracking tool shows that the package associated with this number was "refused" on August 14, 2017, and that the addressee "moved, left no address." The package was returned to sender.

Due to this discrepancy, I am unable to find that Respondent was served. I direct the Division to submit a supplemental declaration explaining the inconsistency of the tracking information or providing other evidence that Respondent was served with the OIP.
