Order Following
Prehearing Conference

Yesterday, I held a prehearing conference by telephone attended by the Division of Enforcement and Respondent Rosalind Herman. I explained that the previous administrative law judge's decision has been vacated by the Securities and Exchange Commission, and that Respondent Herman has a new opportunity to respond to the Division's argument that she should be barred or suspended from the securities industry. I reiterated, however, that she cannot challenge her criminal conviction in this proceeding.

Respondent Herman confirmed that she has received the investigative file from the Division. I reviewed the motions schedule I set in my previous order, and I recite it again here for the purpose of clarity:

November 19, 2018: Motions for summary disposition due.
