**Order Regarding Service
of Orders and Other Filings**

On August 22, 2018, the Securities and Exchange Commission vacated the prior finality orders entered in this proceeding and remanded this matter for further proceedings. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10536, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2058, at *2-3; *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 5955, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2264 (ALJ Sept. 12, 2018). Because there was a finality order and Respondents' registrations were revoked, their obligations under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, including their obligation to maintain an accurate address on file with the Commission, were terminated. For this reason, service by mailing orders and filings to the most recent address shown on Respondents' most recent filings with the Commission may not have been effective. *See* 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.141(b), .150; *cf.* 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii) (presuming, in practice, that the address found on the most recent Commission filing is correct).

I ORDER the Division of Enforcement to serve copies of this order and the order I issued on September 21, 2018, (September 21 order)¹ on Respondents using a method other than attempted delivery to the most recent address shown on their most recent filings with the Commission.

I FURTHER ORDER the Division to file by December 14, 2018, a declaration regarding its efforts to serve the orders, including evidence that delivery was made to an appropriate person or address.

I FURTHER ORDER that Respondents will have fourteen days from service of the September 21 order to submit the proposal for the conduct of further proceedings called for by that order.
