**Order Regarding Motion to Stay  
Deadline to File Declaration**

On November 6, 2018, the Division of Enforcement moved the Securities and Exchange Commission to dismiss this proceeding. On the same date, the Division moved to stay this proceeding, and to stay the deadline to file the declaration of service currently due November 9, 2018, pending resolution of the motion to dismiss.

I am unaware of any authority allowing me to stay this proceeding indefinitely pending the Commission's consideration of a motion to dismiss. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(c)(2), .210(c)(3). However, the requirement that the Division file a declaration of service is **RESCINDED**, and I **ORDER** the Division to file a status report on January 7, 2019, unless the Commission dismisses this proceeding before that date.
