**Order Following
Prehearing Conference**

I previously found that William D. Bucci was served with the order instituting proceedings, and I gave him until November 8, 2018, to show cause why he should not be found in default for failing to file an answer. *William D. Bucci*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 6225, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2895, at *1–2 (ALJ Oct. 18, 2018). He did not respond to the order to show cause or participate in the prehearing conference that was held on November 8.

I therefore ORDER the Division of Enforcement to file a motion for default and sanctions by December 7, 2018. The motion should include legal analysis and evidentiary support for the allegations and requested sanction in accordance with *Rapoport v. SEC*, 682 F.3d 98, 108 (D.C. Cir. 2012), and *Ross Mandell*, Securities Exchange Act of 1934 Release No. 71668, 2014 WL 907416, at *2 (Mar. 7, 2014), *vacated in part on other grounds*, Exchange Act Release No. 77935, 2016 WL 3030883 (May 26, 2016).
