**Order Discharging Order to
Show Cause as to Red Giant
Entertainment, Inc., and
Setting Briefing Schedule**

The Securities and Exchange Commission initiated this proceeding with an order instituting proceedings (OIP) on May 14, 2018, alleging that Respondents have violated Section 13(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 13a-1 and 13a-13 by having securities registered with the Commission and not filing required periodic reports. OIP at 2. On November 20, 2018, counsel for the Division of Enforcement and Grey Fox Holdings Corp. represented that they are engaged in settlement negotiations. *Grey Fox Holdings Corp.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 6352, 2018 SEC LEXIS 3281, at *1 (ALJ Nov. 20, 2018).

I previously ordered Respondents Green Innovations Ltd. and Red Giant Entertainment, Inc., to show cause by November 30, 2018, why the registration of their securities should not be revoked by default due to their failures to file answers or otherwise defend this proceeding. *Id.* On November 30, Benny Powell, Red Giant's CEO, emailed my office about the company's efforts to get current, and submitted a letter stating that the company had not received previous communications regarding this proceeding. I have caused those documents to be filed with the Commission's Office of the Secretary and deem them to be Red Giant's answer to the OIP and response to the order to show cause. As there do not appear to be any genuine issues as to any material facts in dispute, the allegations can be resolved by dispositive motion. Accordingly, the Division of Enforcement may file a dispositive motion as to Red Giant pursuant to 17 C.F.R. § 201.250(b)

by December 17, 2018. Red Giant may file an opposition by January 7, 2019, and the Division may file a reply, if any, by January 14, 2019. *See* 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(a). Red Giant may file a dispositive motion according to the same schedule.

As of the date of this order, Green Innovations has not filed an answer to the OIP, appeared at the prehearing conference, or responded to the order to show cause.
