**Order Following
Prehearing Conference**

The Securities and Exchange Commission instituted this proceeding pursuant to Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 on May 15, 2018. The order instituting proceedings alleges that on May 1, 2018, Angela Rubbo Beckcom Monaco pleaded guilty to one count of conspiracy to commit mail and wire fraud in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1349 and one count of engaging in a monetary transaction in property derived from a specific unlawful activity in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1957 in *United States v. Monaco*, No. 17-cr-417 (D. Colo.).

At today's prehearing conference, I ruled that Respondent's letter dated November 16, 2018, would be considered her answer. I determined that the proceeding could likely be resolved by a motion for summary disposition, which would allow Respondent to advance her position that the industry bar sought by the Division of Enforcement is not in the public interest. 17 C.F.R. § 201.250(b).

I order the following procedural schedule.

December 21, 2018: Division's motion for summary disposition.

January 22, 2019: Respondent's brief in opposition.

February 1, 2019: Division's reply brief.
