**Order Granting Extension** 

The Division of Enforcement has moved for a forty-five day extension of the time to file a dispositive motion. The Division asserts that the extension will allow Respondent Sean P. Finn, who is detained pending trial, time to confer with criminal counsel about the Division's settlement proposal and will allow the Division additional time to evaluate the record for support for its motion. For these reasons and in light of the upcoming holidays, the motion is GRANTED. 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(a), (c). The parties shall file their dispositive motions by January 31, 2019. Responses are due by February 21, 2019, and replies are due March 4, 2019.
