**Order Finding Service,
Directing Respondent
to Show Cause, and
Scheduling Prehearing
Conference**

On December 19, 2018, the Division of Enforcement submitted a declaration of service establishing that Oriental Dragon Corp. was served with the order instituting proceedings (OIP) on December 13, 2018, by Federal Express delivery to the company's registered agent in the Cayman Islands. 17 C.F.R. § 201.141(a)(2)(ii), (iv)(D); *Oriental Dragon Corp.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 6262, 2018 SEC LEXIS 2969, at *6–7 (ALJ Oct. 25, 2018). Its answer was due by December 26, 2018. OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.160(b), .220(b). To date, Respondent has not answered the OIP.

I ORDER Respondent to SHOW CAUSE by February 11, 2019, why the registration of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failure to file an answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. If Respondent fails to respond to this order, it shall be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. OIP at 2; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).

I FURTHER ORDER that a telephonic prehearing conference will be held on February 11, 2019, at 10:30 a.m. EST.
