Order Suspending Briefing Schedule

The parties have separately moved to extend the schedule for summary disposition briefing. The Division of Enforcement's motion is based on the closure of the Securities and Exchange Commission from December 27, 2018, until January 26, 2019, and the stay of all administrative proceedings from January 16 to January 30, 2019. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10602, 2019 SEC LEXIS 5 (Jan. 16, 2019); *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act Release No. 10603, 2019 SEC LEXIS 37 (Jan. 30, 2019). Respondent Snisky seeks an extension because he has lost access to the investigative file previously provided to him in electronic format by the Division pursuant to Rule of Practice 230. Snisky asserts that due to prison rules it would be better for him to receive the investigative file in paper.

I ORDER that the briefing schedule is SUSPENDED. I further ORDER the Division to submit a response to Snisky's motion for discovery by February 8, 2019. In particular, the Division should indicate the size of the investigative file in terms of printed pages.
