Order Extending Supplemental Briefing Schedule

After reviewing the parties' summary disposition briefing, I gave Respondent Joshua D. Mosshart until January 18, 2019, to file a supplemental opposition with supporting evidence and the Division of Enforcement until February 1, 2019, to file a supplemental reply. Joshua D. Mosshart, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 6422, 2018 SEC LEXIS 3628, at *2 (ALJ Dec. 21, 2018). However, due to a lapse in funding, the Securities and Exchange Commission was closed, except for emergency operations, from December 27, 2018, until January 26, 2019, and all administrative proceedings were stayed from January 16 to January 30, 2019. Pending Admin. Proc., Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 10602, 2019 SEC LEXIS 5 (Jan. 16, 2019); Pending Admin. Proc., Securities Act Release No. 10603, 2019 SEC LEXIS 37 (Jan. 30, 2019). Because of the closure, Mosshart was unable to file his supplemental opposition with the Office of the Secretary, and the Division was unable to prepare its supplemental reply. After conferring with Mosshart, the Division has moved to set a new schedule.

Reviewing the Secretary's records, it appears that some materials from Mosshart were filed on January 28, 2019. But to ensure that Mosshart has the opportunity to submit everything that he believes is relevant and that the Division has a chance to review and respond to those materials, I GRANT the Division's motion in full. I ORDER that Mosshart may file his supplemental opposition with supporting evidence by February 15, 2019, and the Division may file its supplemental reply by March 1, 2019.
