The Division of Enforcement has moved to have the protective order entered by the previous administrative law judge in 2016 re-entered. However, that protective order covered only "party documents" obtained by the Division—instead of all documents obtained by the Division, or only those documents containing sensitive information—prior to the institution of this proceeding. *Gary C. Snisky*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 4478, 2016 SEC LEXIS 4758, at *6-7 (ALJ Dec. 22, 2016); *see* 17 C.F.R. § 201.230(a). Accordingly, the Division's motion is DENIED without prejudice to a renewed motion.
