May 31, 2019:	Prehearing briefs are filed.
June 18, 2019:	Final telephonic prehearing conference at 11:00 a.m. Eastern.
June 24, 2019:	Hearing commences in Washington, DC, at Securities and Exchange Commission headquarters, Hearing Room 2, 100 F Street NE, Washington, D.C. 20549.
