Order to Show Cause

After finding that the sole remaining Respondent, Yanglin Soybean, Inc., had been served with the order instituting proceedings (OIP), I directed it to submit an answer and a proposal for the conduct of further proceedings by January 7, 2019. *African Copper Corp.*, Admin. Proc. Rulings Release No. 6397, 2018 SEC LEXIS 3502 (ALJ Dec. 12, 2018). That deadline was extended until February 13, 2019, by order of the Securities and Exchange Commission. *Pending Admin. Proc.*, Securities Act Release No. 10603, 2019 SEC LEXIS 37 (Jan. 30, 2019). To date, it has filed neither an answer nor a proposal and has not otherwise participated in the proceeding.

I ORDER Yanglin Soybean to SHOW CAUSE by March 1, 2019, why the registration of its securities should not be revoked by default due to its failure to file an answer or otherwise defend this proceeding. If it fails to respond to this order, it shall be deemed in default, the proceeding will be determined against it, and the registration of its securities will be revoked. OIP at 3; 17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a)(2), .220(f).
