**Order Requiring  
In Camera Submission**

In response to my March 4, 2019, order addressing Respondent Marian P. Young's subpoena request, the Division of Enforcement stated that it was withholding one document from Young. It submitted a privilege log identifying the document as a report from the Securities and Exchange Commission's Office of Compliance Inspections and Examinations to the Division and stating that it was withholding the report because it is attorney work product and subject to the deliberative process privilege.

To evaluate the Division's claims, I ORDER it to submit the document to my office for in camera review by emailing it to [alj@sec.gov](mailto:alj@sec.gov) by March 11, 2019, without copying Young. For the benefit of Young's understanding, in camera review means that I will examine the document and determine whether there is a legal basis for the Division to withhold it or whether it must be released to Young in part or in full.
