**Order Extending  
Prehearing Schedule**

On April 5, 2019, the Division of Enforcement and Respondents Robert L. Baker, Jacob B. Herrera, and Michael D. Bowen jointly moved to extend the deadlines in this proceeding's prehearing schedule by one month because of personnel changes at the law firm representing Baker and Bowen and to allow additional time to reschedule depositions. For good cause shown, *see* 17 C.F.R. § 201.161(a), I GRANT the motion and order the following schedule:

May 3, 2019:	Discovery closes.
May 10, 2019:	Motions for summary disposition are due.
May 31, 2019:	Oppositions are due.
June 7, 2019:	Replies are due.
September 6, 2019:	Parties to exchange and file witness lists.
September 13, 2019:	Parties to exchange and file exhibit lists and to exchange premarked exhibits. Parties to file any stipulations.
September 27, 2019:	Motions in limine and objections to witnesses and exhibits are due.
November 1, 2019:	A final telephonic prehearing conference will be held at 2 p.m. Eastern.

November 12, 2019:

The hearing will begin at a location to be determined in the Dallas/Fort Worth, Texas, area. The hearing is expected to last three days. My office will secure a hearing location.
